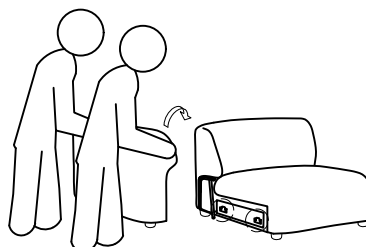
Before You Begin

1. Check Your Order:



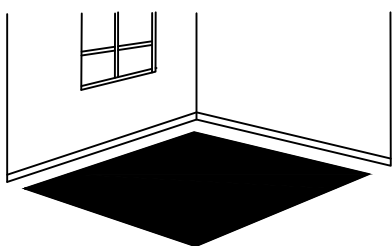
Ensure all boxes have arrived in good condition before starting.

2. Two-Person Assembly:



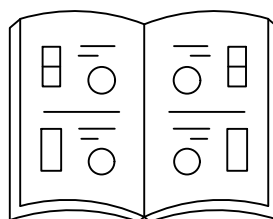
Heavy items require two adults for safe and easy assembly.

3. Prepare Your Space:



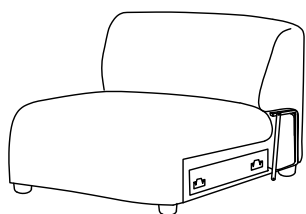
Clear sufficient space for assembly and protect your floor with a mat or cardboard.

4. Read & Organize:



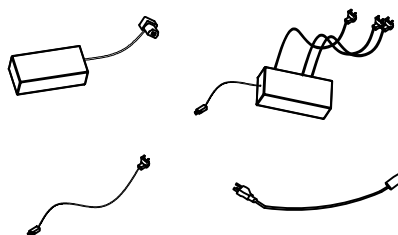
Read all instructions carefully and verify all hardware types and quantities against the list.

5. Inspect Components:



Inspect all sofa connectors and brackets for damage, deformation, or missing parts prior to assembly.

6. Electrical Safety:



DO NOT plug in the power supply if any cables are frayed, split, or damaged.

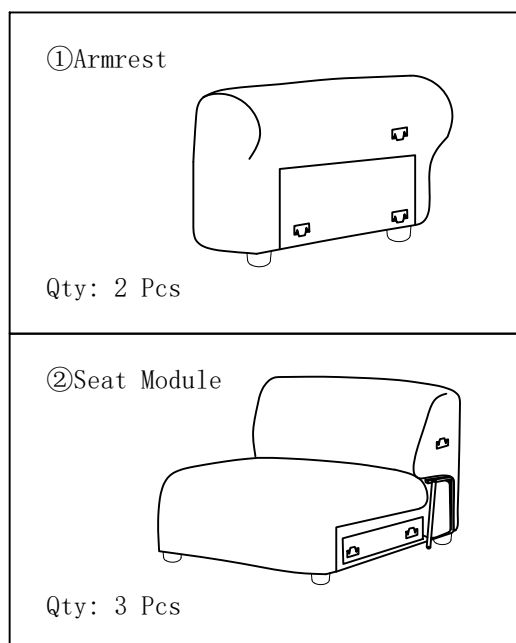

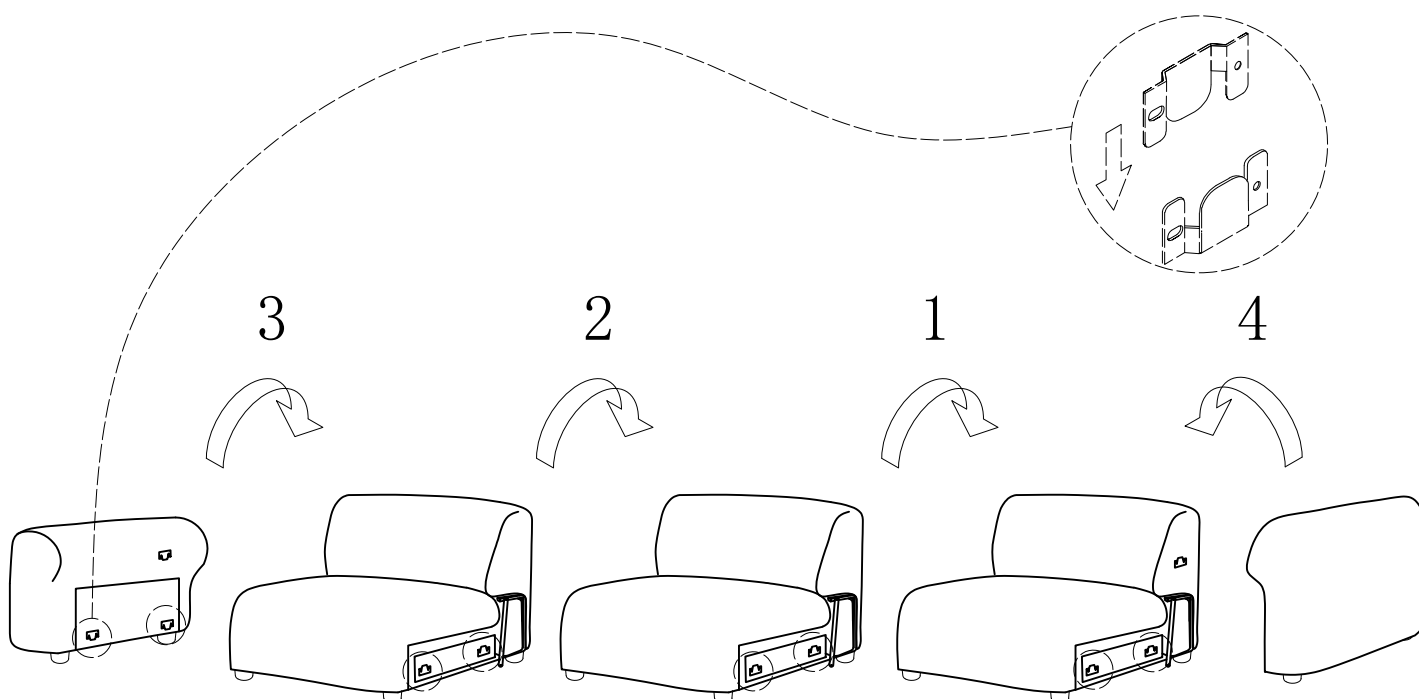
Step-by-Step Assembly Guide

use a wrench to remove the safety cover plate and assemble the main body of the sofa.

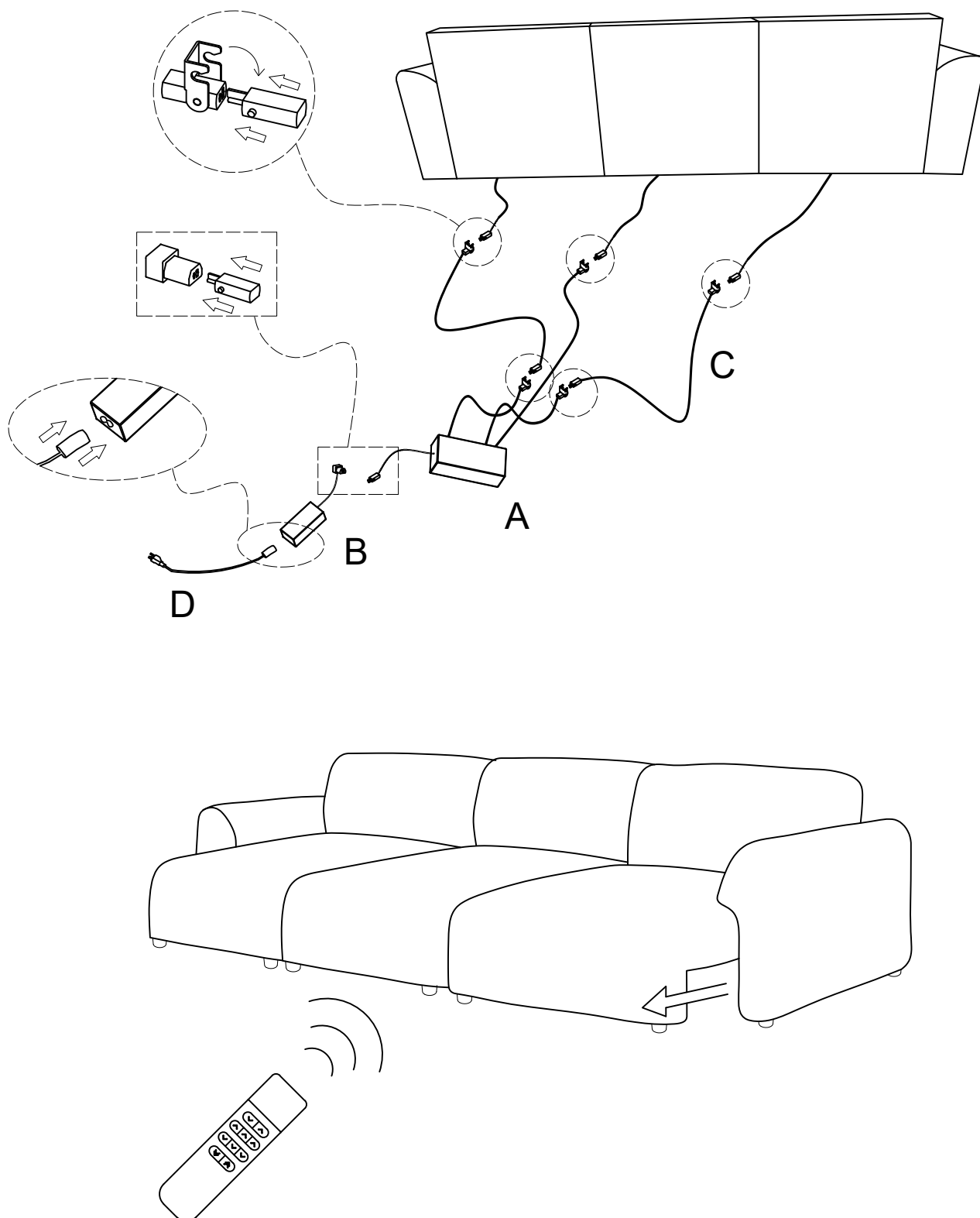


Two adults required



Step 2

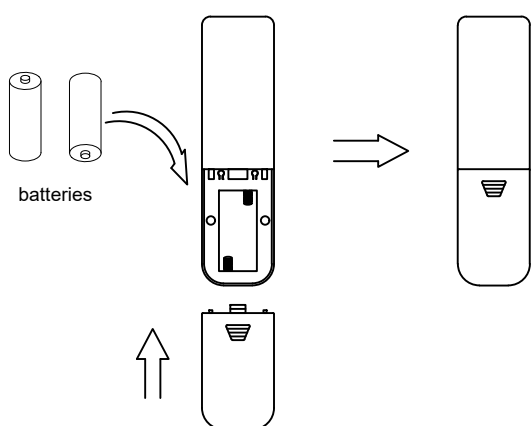
Connect the power cables and use the remote control to test the electric functions.



Remote Control Setup & User Guide

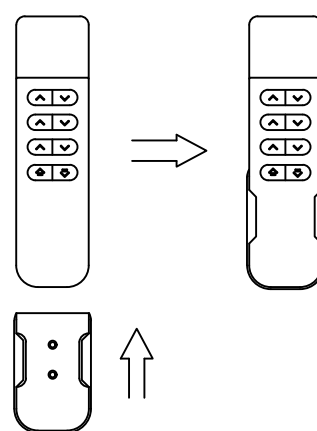
① Battery Installation

Install batteries into the remote control compartment as shown.

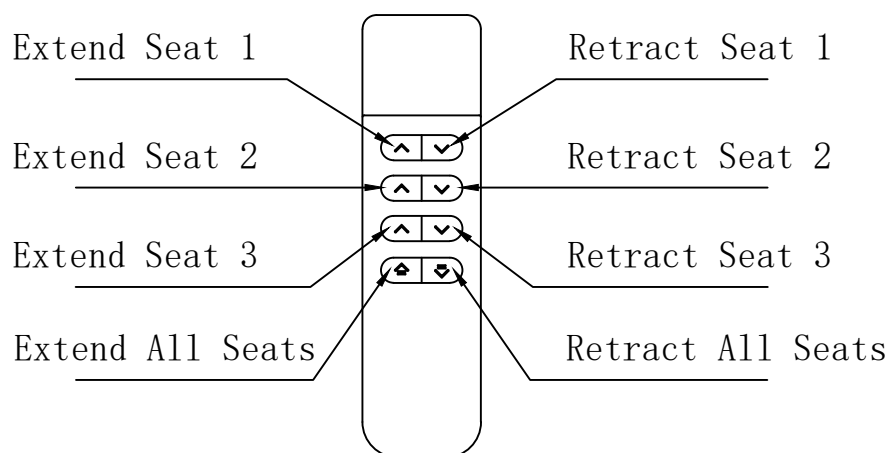


② Wall Mount Bracket Installation

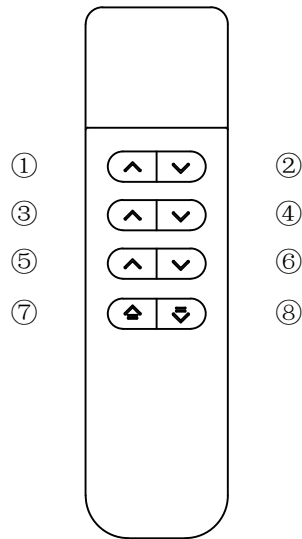
Attach and position the wall-mount bracket according to your preference.

Motor Troubleshooting Guide



1. Remote Control Pairing

If the recliner does not respond to the remote control, or if the remote has been mixed up with another unit, please re-pair the remote by following these steps:

1. Disconnect the power supply, then reconnect it to power on the control box.
2. Within 120 seconds of powering on, press and hold Buttons 1 and 2 simultaneously for 5 seconds.
3. You will hear two beeps from the control box, indicating that pairing is successful.

2. Motor Synchronization Calibration

If the motors are out of sync, perform the following calibration:

1. Press and hold Buttons 7 and 8 on the remote control simultaneously.
2. The three motors will automatically move back and forth three times to perform the synchronization calibration.
3. When all motors return to their original positions, the calibration is complete.
4. The recliner is now synchronized and ready for normal use.

Fabric Care & Maintenance Guide

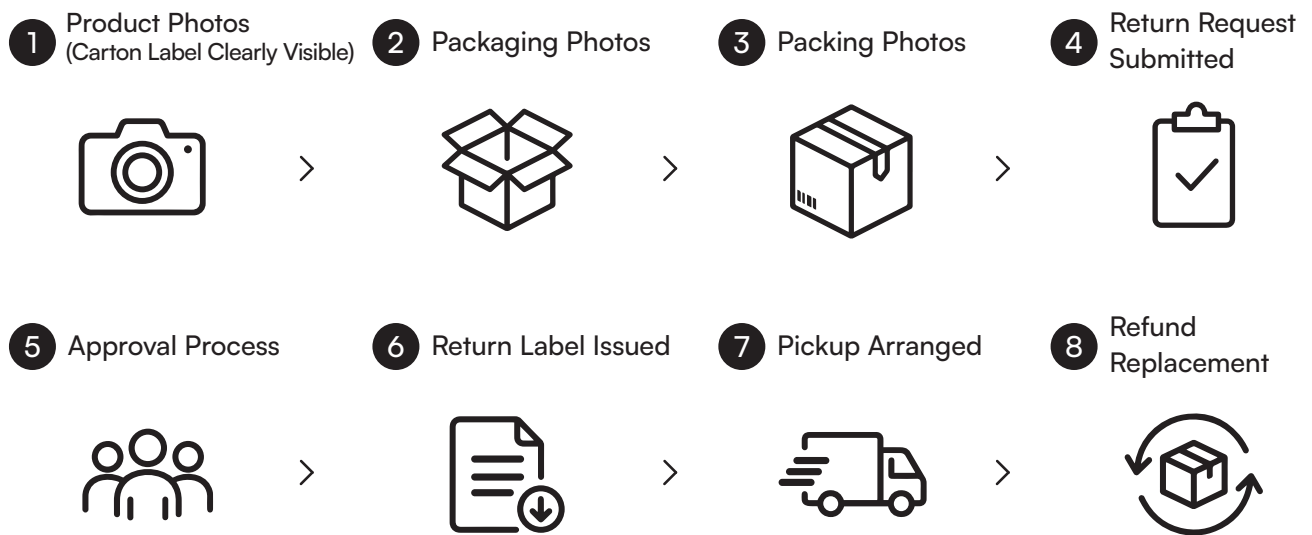
- Vacuum gently in the direction of the fabric pile using a soft brush attachment. Use a lint roller to remove pet hair. After cleaning, gently brush the pile to restore its smooth appearance.
 - Avoid direct sunlight and keep the sofa away from direct airflow from air conditioners or heaters. During humid seasons, maintain proper indoor humidity to help prevent mold and mildew. Keep sharp objects such as jewelry and keys away from the fabric. If loose threads appear, carefully trim them with scissors—do not pull.
 - Always clean by gently blotting. Do not rub or scrub back and forth. Allow the fabric to air dry completely in a shaded, well-ventilated area before brushing the pile.
 - Food & Beverage Stains: Mix a small amount of mild neutral cleaner with warm water. Gently blot the stain with a clean cloth, then blot again with a water-dampened cloth to remove any detergent residue. Allow the fabric to dry completely before brushing.
 - Do not use alcohol, bleach, hot water, or stiff-bristled brushes.

Common Fabric Issues & Solutions

- Flattened Fabric Pile: Use a garment steamer at a safe distance on a low heat setting to gently loosen the fibers. Allow the area to cool completely, then brush the pile back into place.
- Mold / Mildew: For minor mildew spots, gently dab the area with a diluted white vinegar solution and allow it to air dry completely in a well-ventilated area. For severe mold or mildew, professional upholstery cleaning is recommended.
- Large-Scale Stains: For extensive or stubborn stains, professional upholstery cleaning is recommended. Avoid repeated water-based cleaning, as excessive moisture may damage the fabric.
